The motor-ambulance was then practically an unknown quantity so far as actual warfare went, and the military author ities stipulated that our drivers were not to wear uniform, nor, under any circumstances, to go near the firing line. There was to be no Red Cross on the cars. Truly, the mission ofthe motor ambulance was to be extremely limited. They were simply to go about far behind the hring-line and pick up wounded men who could not be carried to the field hospitals men, for example, who had crawled for safety into abandoned cottages and barns.
