The state engineer then examines the road and if he considers it of sufficient importance to warrant state aid, he orders a survey, together with plans and estimates of the cost of the improvement. These are then submitted by him to the board of supervisors, and if approved by the board, the contract is let and the road constructed under the supervision of the state engineer. Fifty per cent. of the cost of the improvement is paid by the state, thirty-five per cent. by the county, and fifteen per cent. by the town, or if the property owners have petitioned, by those whose lands are benefited. When completed the road must be kept in repair by the town. The state engineer is required to collect statistics and information concerning roads and advise with local oflicers and persons interested in road improvement. He must hold at least one public meeting annually in each county in the interest of good roads) Since the passage of the law the state appropriations in aid of highways have been as follows: 1898, 50, 000; 1899, 50, 000; 1900, 150, 000; 1901, 420, 000. Mama. In this state there is no state commissioner of highways, but state aid is given to towns constructing improved roads. On the request of the municipal officers of any town, the county commissioners designate some road as a 1nain thoroughfare, and the road thus designated becomes a state road.
