In again meeting the subscribers and friends of the British Schools, the committee believe they may bear testimony to the continued efficiency of these institutions, As will be seen by the statement appended to this report, the number of children in attendance is below that of last year, when there were 357 boys and 375 girls; this year 334 boys and 355 girls, showing a decrease of 23 boys and 16 girls. It is difficult to account for these fluctuations, to which all schools are liable. The committee have also gratefully to acknowledge a grant of 10, contributed by Alexander Eedgrave, Esq. , from the Factory Fine Fund. These special contributions have enabled the committee to reimburse the treasurer the balance with which for years the school has been encumbered, and also to effect some improvements on the premises, the want of which had long been felt. The treasurer of the girls school, Mrs. Thorp, has presented a balance sheet of the receipts and payments for...
