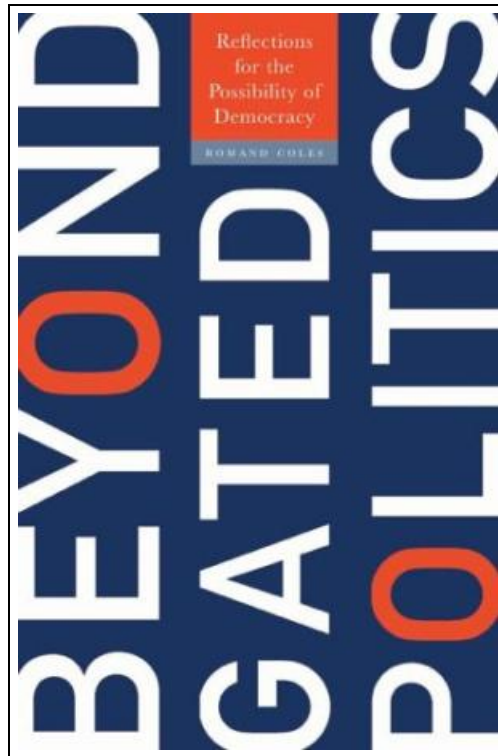

Within the United States, opposition to increasingly antidemocratic political and economic policies has been either nonexistent or unsuccessful. This trend includes, but far exceeds, the Bush administration s policies from the Patriot Act and the war on Iraq to the Clear Channelization of the media and the private development of public lands. In *Beyond Gated Politics* , political theorist and grassroots activist Romand Coles argues that the survival of democracy depends on recognizing the failings of disengaged liberal democracy - the exclusions and subjugations that accompany every democratic we, for example - and experimenting with more radical modes of democratic theory and action. In doing so, he not only moves beyond the paradigms of political liberalism, deliberative democracy, and communitarian republicanism, but also cultivates multidimensional modes of public discourse that reflect and sustain the creative tension at the heart of democratic life and responsibility. This book offers an innovative intervention into the landscape of contemporary political theory.
