




Calling the Horses: A Racing Autobiography (Hardback)

The most recent edition of Calling the Horses was published in 1994, and the twenty years since then have brought many fresh episodes in the ongoing Peter O Sullevan story, including the last racing days of his great friend Lester Piggott in 1995, his commentary on the Bomb Scare Grand...
