Therefore, studying problems, gender disparities and possible solutions to the problems of deaf students with regard to schools, homes and the community is crucial. Gender, deafness and harassment are the core concepts in this work. The purpose of the study is to investigate the problems, gender disparities and possible solutions. With the misconceptions and negative attitudes of parents of deaf children which were identified during my master's study, deaf girls have very limited access and success to education (e.g. a 21 years old deaf woman in a pre-school).
