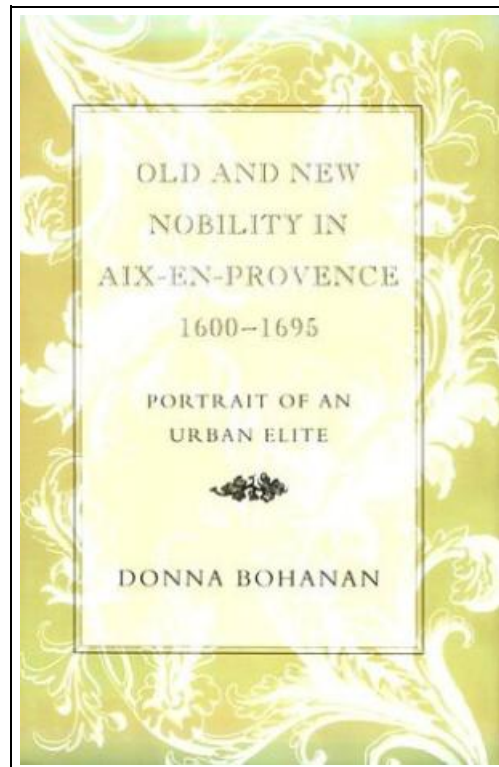

Previous scholars perceived an aristocracy divided by competition between old military families (nobility of the sword) and a new bureaucratic group of middle-class origin (nobility of the robe). Looking at a regional elite in southern France, where legal and social traditions differed from those of the north, Bohanan finds that shared habits of urban living caused leading families of whatever origin to adapt similarly to their social environment and to succeed in forming a unified elite. Because scholars and students can use this brief study, it belongs in academic history collections.].
