In addition to this a print cut to the form of the aperture required, is applied to the end of the bearing, forming an additional guide for the core. This is the method ordinarily followed, but if the exigencies of the work demand it, we may omit either one of these prints. If the print only is retained, make it much thicker, or the core may not be securely placed. The core-box will be made as shown in plan, Fig. 78. In sections it resembles Figs. 75 and 76, but at one end it is longer as much as the thickness of the print. The prints for the bolt-cores cannot be put on as before, as they would lock the pattern in the sand. The prints to...



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
