In this extraordinary book, Elmer Gertz recounts his long struggle in what legal scholars regard as the second most important libel case in legal history: Gertz v. Robert Welch, Inc. Gertz's ordeal began in Chicago during the violent peace demonstrations of 1968. A youth, Ronald Nelson, was killed by a Chicago policeman, Richard Nuccio. Gertz represented the Nelson family in civil suits against Nuccio and the Chicago police department. After Nuccio was convicted of murder, the John Birch Society published an article in its journal, American Opinion, claiming that Nuccio was framed by Communists. Gertz was targeted as a prime Communist instigator. The file on Elmer Gertz in Chicago Police Intelligence takes a big, Irish cop to lift, wrote Alan Stang, the author of the article. After reading and studying the article, Gertz sprang into action. He learned that the magazine was published by Robert Welch, Inc., against which he promptly filed suit, charging that it had defamed him by publishing highly harmful lies impugning his reputation and patriotism.
