

Conceived by international conceptual artist Rita McBride and produced with the Whitney Museum of American Art, one of America s preeminent art institutions, and Printed Matter, Inc., one of New York s leading artist-run centers, the Ways Books are creating waves in literary and visual arts circles everywhere. Where Heartways took on the romance genre, and Futureways science fiction, Crimeways tackles the genre of detective novels with aplomb: tales of cops, private investigators, and art-world fugitives that simultaneously work within and outside the detective novel genre.
