It is in the proper sense, a general hospital, admitting almost all diseases except small-pox, and is arranged into four departments; namely, Medical, Surgical, Gynaecological and Lying-in, and Ophthalmological and Otological. Terms of admission vary with the accommodations. In the larger, or what are called the public wards, the price is \$7.00 per week; and in the private rooms, of which there are a large number, the price is \$15.00 per week. There are constantly in the Hospital a considerable number of patients who pay nothing, they being kept as charity patients. The institution has also an arrangement with the Chicago Relief and Aid Society by which 40 beds are kept at the disposal of that Society for the accommation of such...
