The hymn, Oh, My Father, was written by Eliza R. Snow Smith, the daughter of Oliver and Rosetta Pettibone Snow. She was born in Becket, Berkshire county, Mass. , Jan. 21, 1804. Her parents moved to Mantua, Portage county, Ohio, when she was a child. Very early in life she developed a literary taste and acquired considerable local recognition as a poet by contributing to various periodicals. At the age of 21 she was invited to write for publication a requiem for John Adams and Thomas Jefferson, both of whom died on the 4th of July, 1826. The production of her pen in response to this request brought to her additional fame as a writer. She received a careful education in the schools of her time and neighborhood, and was not only accomplished in literary pursuits, but was skilled in household duties. In the year 1835 she learned from her sister about the Prophet Joseph Smith and the Latter Day Saints, then located in Kirtland, in the same state in which she resided. The tidings her sister brought regarding the great latter day work were joyous to Elizas ears. Her only fear was that the news was only too good to be true. She received the Gospel message with her whole heart. Bidding her old home and associates farewell, and forsaking all worldly prospects before her, she repaired to Kirtland. Arriving there she boarded with the Prophets family and engaged...
