

His comics range from bestsellers featuring the most universally recognized superhero franchises ("All-Star Superman", "New X-Men", "Batman") to more independent, creator-owned work ("The invisibles", "The Filth, We3") that defies any generic classification. This volume examines how Morrison uses this fusion of styles to challenge contemporary theories of language and meaning, seeking to develop new modes of expression grounded in comics' capacity for visual narrative and the fantasy genres' ability to make figurative meanings literal.
