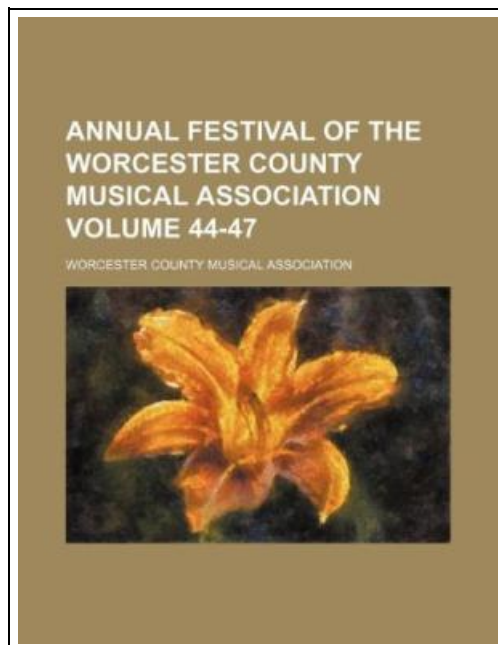

Darkness prevails, the music is first soft, then rises clamorously and swells into fury. At the climax, the fire bursts forth in the streets, children rejoice and dance, and there are heard voices of praise and love. The music was heard in London, Chicago and New York, in February, 1902, and in Boston in March. The concert arrangement calls for these instruments in the orchestra: glockenspiel, harmonium, and harp behind the scenes; three flutes (one interchangeable with piccolo), two oboes, cor anglais, clarinet in D (interchangeable with bass-clarinet), two clarinets in A, three bassoons (one interchangeable with double bassoon), four horns, three trumpets, three trombones, tuba, glockenspiel, kettle-drums, side drum, big...
