The Caudine Disaster, Hannibal s Campaign in Italy, and the Roman Subjugation of Macedonia, are typical events in the three periods of the history of the Roman republic - the struggle for dominion over Italy, for dominion over the Western Seas, for dominion over the civilised world. Papirius, Hannibal, and Aemilius are characters worth studying. And though as treated by Livy it cannot be denied that there is a certain sameness in the rhetorical manner in which they all express their views, this is not a fault of style so much as of the age in which he lived. We can easily excuse where we are so deeply interested. Livy s narrative, glowing with all the colours of fancy, can no more deceive us into mistaking it for a page of history, than we could mistake Henry V...
