

For example, Title I funds could be used along with ESEA Title II (Improving Teacher Quality State Grants) funds to support a literacy program or to support a supplemental component, such as small group instruction, of a larger state-funded or locally funded literacy 24 In this case, the Title II funds might be used to provide initiative. professional development to teachers in the literacy program, and Title I might be used to hire teachers for small group instruction. 24 States may use Title II funds to increase the number of highly qualified teachers in classrooms. This may be accomplished by recruiting and hiring highly qualified teachers as well as by providing professional development to help teachers become highly qualified.
