

The discrepancies in latitude, longitude, and azimuth were very small over this stretch of about 900 miles along the line of triangulation, amounting to 0. 16 in latitude, 0. 44 in longitude, and 5. 75 in in azimuth. The changes introduced by the adjustment were equivalent to a change of about the 1100000 part in the lengths of the lines. The average change in the angles was less than 0. 10. The greatest change in any angle was 0. 30. The probable error of an angle over this stretch as given in Professional Papers No. 24 is about 0. 30.
