The Dinner Club is a collection of tales related by members of a club, where each character present entertains his fellow members with a story connected to his trade. Herman Cyril McNeile was born on 28th September 1888, in Bodmin, England. McNeile s writing career began in 1915 when the Daily Mail serialised Reminiscences of Sergeant Michael Cassidy . He wrote under the pseudonym Sapper due to British Army personnel being barred from publishing under their real names. McNeile s most famous creation was that of Bull-Dog Drummond in 1920. Drummond was an ex-army captain with a thirst for adventure and defeating bad guys. This character went on to appear in ten full-length novels by McNeile and several further works by Gerard Fairlie.
