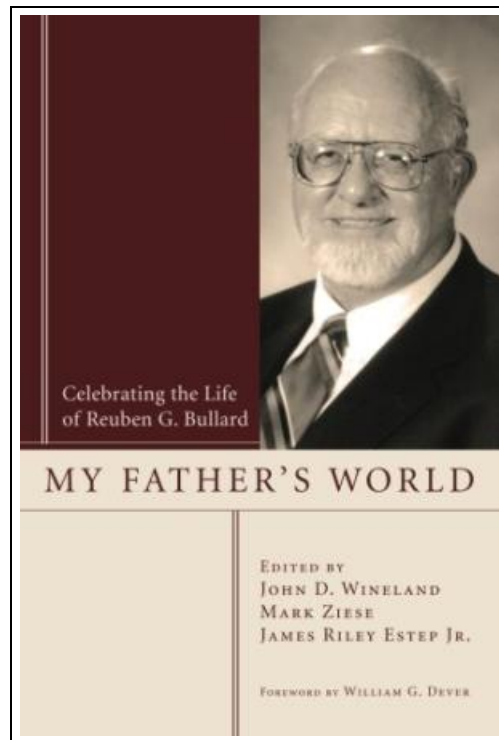

Bullard (d. 2004), who sought and succeeded in changing the lives of his students by his passion for learning about his Father s world and his devotion to God s Word.
