Neuware - The idea of a series of International Conferences on Risk Analysis initiated almost 10 years ago when Lutz Edler and Christos Kitsos were working together on a project on Cancer Risk Assessment. The International Statistical Institute - Committee on Risk Analysis (ISI- CRA) backed up the idea and the first Conference was organised with great success, in Athens in 2003 by the Technological Educational Institute of Athens. The main focus of the conference was on cancer risk management and assessment. As a result the acronym of the conference was ICCRA (International Conference on Cancer Risk Assessment). ICCRA2 and ICCRA3 followed the first successful conference. ICCRA2 took place in the Greek island of Santorini in 2007 and ICCRA3 in Porto Heli, Greece in 2009. Two important international publications came out of the above three events. The book titled Recent Advances in Quantitative Methods in Cancer and Human Risk Assessment (2007, Wiley) was the product of the joint efforts of Christos Kitsos and Lutz Edler. Volume 15 of the international publication series Biometrie und Medizinische Informatik Greifswalder Seminarberichte (2009, Shaker Verlag) was the result of the editorial work of Christos Kitsos, Alex...
