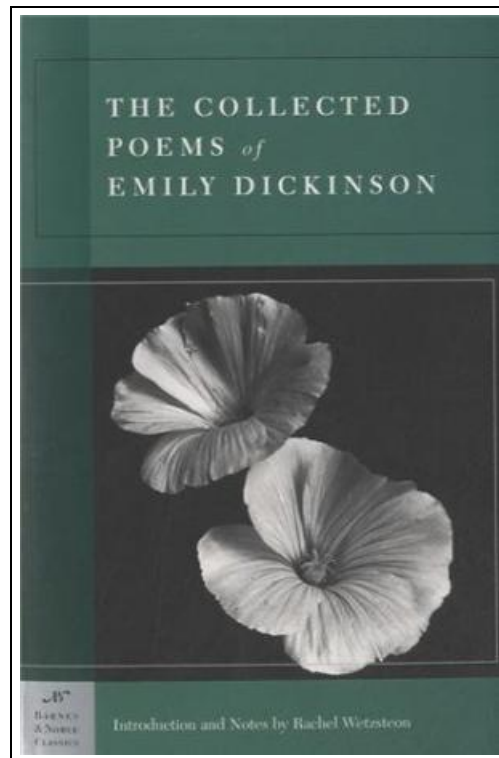

Dickinson's poetry is remarkable for its tightly controlled emotional and intellectual energy....
