Excerpt: . . . For some fees, the fee rate is set in statute. This includes (1) premium fees for employment based applications; and (2) fees on certain employers sponsoring an individual for H-1B nonimmigrant worker status. Premium fee collections are deposited into the Immigration Examinations Fee Account, along with other fees set by regulation pursuant to 31 U. S. C. 1356 (m). The collection of fees imposed upon employers sponsoring aliens for H-1B status are deposited into the H-1B Nonimmigrant Petitioner Account. Persons seeking immigration or naturalization benefits mail their applications and associated fees (when applicable) to one of four service centers or one of two lockbox facilities, depending on the form type and geographic location of the applicant. Contract employees at the service centers and designated financial agent employees at the lockbox facilities are responsible for the initial processing of applications: mail operations, data collection, fee collection, and file operations.
