This second monograph is avowedly critical and constitutes the first sustained critique of management control.;The papers in this collection are all published here for the first time. They are classified under two main headings: theoretical discussions of various aspects of management control and six empirical studies including the glass and coal industries, the accountancy and nursing professions, and treasuryship in local government.;Since the philosophy of the collection revolves around a belief in critique, the volume concludes with two auto-critiques which subject the main papers to scrutiny.;Wai Fong Chua is co-author, with R.M.S.Wilson, of Managerial Accounting - Method and Meaning . Tony Lowe is co-editor of New Perspectives in Management Control , with John Machin. Tony Puxty is an author and editor of several books including Financial Management - Method and Meaning (with J.C.Dodds).
