Because there was not room for the outside horse between the draught hook and the post; because the draught hooks in this gin house were put into the levers at points which made it necessary to cut notches into each of the middle posts for the passage of the swingl etrees. We will now explain the harm of throwing the outside horses thus inside the line of the draught hook. The lever from which this diagram was made measured 14 feet from the center of the master wheel to the draught hook, and the gentleman who owned the machine thought that his horses had the advantage of 14 feet levers.
