The vast monumental complex, with its turreted palace, well-constructed fortifications and extensive gardens, represents a unique example of a noble residence, entirely furnished and rich in valuable collections. Inhabited continuously by the Thun counts until 1982, the castle was acquired in 1992 by the Autonomous Province of Trento and has undergone long and extensive renovation and restoration involving both the architectural structure and the works of art.
