As given in the four Gospels, the spiritual takes precedency, and unless we be aware the picturesqueness of the divine revelation obscures its psychological meaning. St. Matthew gives the historical as a clothing of the latter. He begins his record by the genealogy of the Jews: The book of the generations of Jesus Christ, son of David, son of Abraham. Abraham begat Isaac; and Isaac begat Jacob; and Jacob begat Judas and his brethren. Now in my treatise of Genesis I have enunciated that the character Abraham involved the expression of mans fourfold evolution with especial reference to the key to Intellectual Evolution. Therefore, in its psychological meaning the word Abraham meant prophetic vision, or focused energy begotten of religious habit controlling mind...
