The chief object of Government was to ascertain whether, in its great principles, especially respecting the treatment of religion, the system would be received by any considerable proportion of the people, Roman Catholic and Protestant. We have never, till this day, had it in our power to carry those measures into effect which we ourselves have represented as necessary to the efficiency of the system. Up till this day, we have not a single schoolmaster educated by us, or remunerated as we have again and again represented...
