OVERVIEW: Updates from the *MLA Handbook* 8th edition (2016)

The types of sources we use to research projects are always evolving, and the new 8th MLA Handbook demonstrates an approach to simplify the task of citing them. Instead of asking writers to learn unique formats for each type of source, MLA will emphasize citing more shared across sources and formatting those with consistent rules. There are three new chapters, so consider when writing entries for one of the new ones: every source contains some contribution that not necessarily all—of these.

The Core Elements of a Works-Cited Entry	
1. Author	Who created the source—or whose work on the source you discuss is emphasized first and foremost.
2. Title of source	The title of the specific source you are citing. This could be a book, book or other print matter, a print item in one of the arts.
3. Title of container	The title of a larger source containing the source you are citing. When a source stands alone (like a whole film or novel), there are no containers. When an entry is published in a periodical (larger source), then that periodical is called a container.
4. Other contributors	Nonauthorial contributors to the work, such as editors, translators, or performers.
5. Version	Designation of a source that appears to name that one edition, such as a book, the 8th edition.
6. Number	Number indicating the source's place in a sequence, such as volume and issue numbers for journals, but not serial and special numbers for different issues.
7. Publisher	Organization that produces or sponsors the source, following its format.
8. Publication date	When the source was made available to the public. This might be a year, month, a specific date, or even a specific season.
9. Location	Where to find a specific source. This could be page numbers for print sources, a URL or DOI for online sources, or the location of a library or performance.
