Section 3 (b) (1) defines the post of Deputy Chief in the DOJ. The Deputy Chief is responsible for investigating, prosecuting, and co-ordinating both investigative and prosecutorial actions in cases where there is an alleged violation of a criminal civil rights statute no later than December 31, 1969 that resulted in a death. Section 3 (b) (2) allows the Deputy Chief to coordinate investigative activities with state and local officials. While this coordination is not required, the fact that most of these cases will lack federal jurisdiction underscores the importance of state and local participation in the investigations in order to bring about efficient and...
