The problems listed above result in a very inefficient roadway system which is particularly apparent during the peak commuter periods. Future Improvements This study identified two improvement options to meet the soils of the Study. Alternative A provides for an improved roadway configuration which generally includes the following: Alternative A resignation of Atlantic Avenue and Lincoln Streets as one-way northbound while South street and (purchase street) would become one-way southbound. All southbound traffic would be eliminated on Atlantic Avenue and all northbound traffic on Surface Artery...
