In a slow, measured voice with flashes of wit and humour, Munk considers her universe - remembering, imagining, observing, recording, never losing sight of the beauty and mystery that surround her. Barbara Munk's mother was "one of the Huble girls," members of a distinguished northern BC pioneer family, and her father, Tom Corless, was a pioneering bush pilot.
