The College offers a course of two years, consisting of three days instruction weekly, open to those possessing the Pharmacy Student Certificate of the New York State Education Department, based on fifteen Regents counts or one years work in an accredited high school, and leading to the degree of Graduate in Pharmacy. To graduates of this and of other courses properly qualifying for advanced work, a Graduate Course of one year in the microscopical and chemical analysis of foods and drugs is open. As a department of Columbia University, the College also offers a course of two years, of four days instruction weekly, open to those presenting the Academic Equivalent Certificate of the State Education Department, based on 60 Regents counts or four years work in an accredited high school and leading to the degree of Pharmaceutical Chemist.
