

D. 1620 The Life and Death of Mary Magdalene exists in two MSS. of the first quarter of the 17th century, Harleian 6211 (p.56 - 94); and Rawlinson 41 in the Bodleian. The latter MS. contains the author s name, Thomas Robinson, plainly at full length; the former his initials T. R., and his full name blotted out, but still legible. The Rawlinson MS. contains another legend of another writer, entitled The Life of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and has the following dedication to its Marry Magdalene: A small part of the poem, altered and modernised, appeared in 1869 (February and March), in a monthly periodical called The Westminster Abbey Magazine or Reminiscences of Past Literature, which lived but three months. At the beginning is a foot-note: This poem, which now for the first time sees light of day in print, was probably written by Sir Philip Sidney - it is thoroughly Spenserian in style, and...
