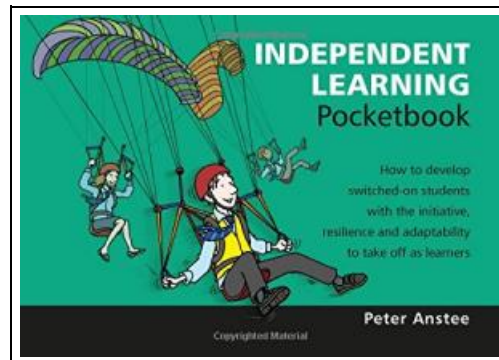

A look at how to inspire and encourage ambition is followed by a focused and practical section on meta-learning and meta-cognitive strategies that can easily be implemented in class. There are similarly practical approaches to building initiative and tenacity and encouraging collaboration. A chapter on self-regulation and embedding independence brings the book to a neat close. Cartoons, diagrams and visual prompts support the text throughout. Author Peter Anstee is an experienced secondary school teacher with considerable expertise in leading the development of teaching and learning. His Differentiation Pocketbook is one of the most popular titles in the Teachers Pocketbooks Series.
