The increase in net cash farm incomes of the last two years, followed three years of declining incomes from the level which was obtained for the period 1925 to 1929. Several years Of better earnings will be nec essary to compensate for the excessive losses sustained during the three years Of 1930, 1931, and 1932. In reading the following tables it should be kept in mind that these data represent only those farms whose Operators are progressive and business-like enough to keep accounts and submit them for analysis. Repeated studies have shown that the average farm Operator enrolled in this accounting service earns a higher rate Of interest on his invested capital than that Of the average Of the rank and file Of all farmers.
