It has also been condensed, in the preface and throughout the lectures, partly by being purged of redundancies which are perhaps pardonable in oral communication of ideas, but are less suited for thoughtful readers; and it now appears in one volume instead of two. The book has been further modified by occasional introduction of new matter, intended to present its central principle in fuller light. The whole has been arranged in Three Parts, preceded by two preliminary lectures in which an expanded Natural Theology is defined, and articulated in its three logically indemonstrable data. A Retrospect of the central course of thought follows the last Part. It is hoped that these changes may make the book less unworthy of the indulgent reception and sympathetic criticism with which the first edition has been signally favoured abroad, in America and in Australia, not less than in this country.
