The three short stories in this book are all inspired by experiences that I have had while living in Ventimiglia Alta, a medieval village perched on a headland overlooking the western Italian Riviera and nearby French Cote d Azur. Centuries Apart and A Grave Mistake may very loosely be described as gentle ghost stories. Re-Routed features specters of an entirely different sort. Terrifying, horrifying and frightening they most definitely are not. In Re-Routed, Centuries Apart and A Grave Mistake I will take you from the magnificent scenic railway line that links the mountainous Riviera hinterland to Northern Italy s fertile Po Valley plains; to the millenniums-old Roman road that crosses the world-famous Hanbury Botanic Gardens, and finally to a graveyard in a small French town just a few kilometers across the Italian-French border from Ventimiglia.
