

Our hospitals for the insane are as good as any in the country, but mental disease is not decreasing in Virginia. Our methods of dealing with criminals, paupers and other anti-social groups have not resulted in the reduction of their numbers; the increase of anti-social classes appears to keep pace with the growth of...
