In either case, the manual is meant for the beginner, before he has read widely in more advanced works, or at least before he has developed from wide reading and experience a workable system of his own. In keeping with both of these aims, the volume offers a brief though not superficial introduction to the many inter-related problems of play presentation, as the actor must sooner or later face them. The seasoned student-actor who has had even a minimum of formal training can of course be expected to bring to his work some knowledge of the broader problems of production, and some awareness of the director s aims and responsibilities.
