In the 1800s this area was known simply as The Corners. In 1865 John Henry Amos opened a general store and was the first postmaster. The name Mossley was chosen from two family names, the Mossips and the Lees. Mossley had a hotel, a cheese factory, a harness repair shop, and there were dressmakers and music teachers. Malahide Township was named for Malahide Castle in Malahide, Ireland,...
