

At Kiev, Southern Russia, where the general surface of the country is 630 feet above sea level, the Dnieper river has cut a trough in the plain 350 feet deep and deposited a loess 50 feet in thickness. Below this loess Armashevsky, a Russian geologist, found paleolithic implements. The professor made a report of his discovery to the International Congress in 1897. In 1900 Dr. G. Frederick W right of America, and the professor visited the locality where the implements were found and made a survey of the conditions. REMARKS. -----The significance attached to this example consists in the fact that the implements were found, not in the loess, but below it.
