After it had been stated that certain changes of the papilla nervi optici were almost constantly met with in cases of true Glaucoma, German Opthalmologists believed themselves justified to look upon these alterations as the distinctive features of Glaucoma. These alterations are as follows: First, a change of form in the papilla, which appears concave; further, a change in the relation between the vessels of the papilla, and finally a pulsation in the art. centralis retinae. More recent observations have shown, however, that these alterations may be found in cases where the external phenomena of Glaucoma, as adopted by the older opthalmological writers, are absent altogether. The consequence was, that the term Glaucoma was extended far beyond the former boundaries, and applied to cases that in older times were put under the head of amaurosis chorioidalis, amaurosis retinae, a. cerebralis.
