Excerpt from South Dakota s Timber Resources In terms of geography and forests, east meets west in South Dakota in a rather dramatic way. The Prairie Plains in the east gradually give way to the grasslands of the Great Plains in the west as elevation increases by some feet between the Minne sota border and Rapid City. The forests in the Plains regions are primarily associated with water - reservoirs, lakes, and the dominating Missouri River and its major tributaries such as the Belle Fourche, Cheyenne, and Big White. Collectively these forests make up only 10 percent of the total forest land in the State and consist primarily of tree species associated with the eastern hardwood forests - elm, ash, basswood, and so forth. In the far western portion of the State and spilling over into northeastern Wyoming are the Black Hills. This isolated mountainous island of granite, limestone, and meta morphic rock thrust up through the western plains is a national geologic landmark treasured for its beauty and history. It is roughly 100 miles long and 60 miles wide and rises from...
