He was also a journalist and a broadcasting narrator. S. T. Joshi has stated that his work is more consistently meritorious than any weird writers except Dunsanys and that his short story collection Incredible Adventures (1914) may be the premier weird collection of this or any other century. Blackwood was born in Shooters Hill (today part of south-east London, but then part of northwest Kent)...
