Here then, in the College of Douai, the work of making a new English translation was begun. The principal translator was a first-rate scholar, Dr. Gregory Martin, teacher of Hebrew and Biblical Literature at the College, with Dr. Allen and Dr. Bristowe as Coadjutors. Both Testaments, the Old and the New, appear to have been ready for issue together, but lack of the necessary funds - our poor estate in banishment as the editor puts it - compelled them to be content at first with the issue of the New Testament only. Before this eould be accomplished, however, political troubles had compelled the authorities to remove their College from Douai to Rhemes (sic) and there the new translation of the New Testament was published in
