Richard Zacks wryly chronicles how young Roosevelt went head to head with Tammany Hall, took midnight rambles with muckraker Jacob Riis, and tried to convince two million New Yorkers to enjoy wholesome family fun. And inevitably, when Roosevelt's crackdown succeeded too well, even his supporters turned on him, TR discovered that New York loves its sin more than its salvation.
