



Phonological Awareness Skills in German-speaking Preschool Children

Neuware - Ausgezeichnet mit dem dbl Forschungspreis Phonological awareness (PA) defines the ability to analyse and manipulate the phonological structure of a spoken word. It is a heterogeneous skill that starts developing at preschool age and is important for pronunciation as well as literacy skills. The present project investigated the PA competences of 38 monolingual, normally-developing German preschool children a few months before starting school. The aims of the pilot study were to advance the development of a reliable and comprehensive PA test battery for German preschool children- to gain insight into the average PA skills in German-speaking children near school enrolment in general, both aims were achieved within the scope of the current project and the results are discussed concerning test reliability, average PA performances and the influence of letter-knowledge on the PA scores.
