This group later became NASA (National Aeronautics and Space Administration). She has become famous as one of the subjects of a bestselling book by Margot Lee Shetterly. The book is titled Hidden Figures. It tells about black women math experts who helped develop planes for World War II. Their work was an important part of winning the war. They also worked on the space program. This work helped put a man on the moon. The book was made into a movie, also called Hidden Figures, with Octavia Spencer playing Vaughn. While she reached an important position within NACA, Dorothy still faced problems with segregation. Segregation is enforced separation of different racial groups in a country, community, or establishment. African Americans -or colored as they were often called then - faced segregation.
