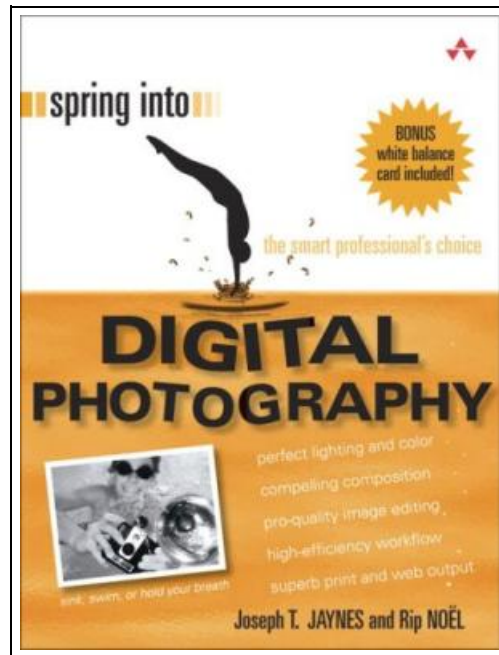

This book covers the complete photography lifecycle, including taking the shot, manipulating the image with Adobe Photoshop Elements, and outputting the image to print or screen, and shows how to transfer traditional photographic skills, such as lighting and composition, to the digital realm. It contains a special white balance card produced by the authors. Taking a digital photograph is easy, but producing a great digital photograph is much more difficult. This is the book for technical professionals who are not satisfied with just taking okay pictures, but who want to learn what it takes to take really great digital photographs. The authors explain the entire process involved, starting with taking the shot, moving on to how to manipulate the image using Adobe's popular Photoshop Elements package, and ending with reproducing the image, either in print or electronically. They discuss how to transfer important skills the reader might have in traditional photography, such as composition and lighting, to the new digital medium. with all Spring Into books, the material is covered in one and two page spreads of self-contained lessons.
