Reconnecting with Baghdad friends, he is embroiled in their continuing suffering as civil war divides or exiles them and destroys the Baghdad he knew. The novel provides a close-up view of the Iraq war and the cultural and political naivete that has led to this American dilemma. The author spent nineteen years in the Middle East, five in Baghdad, and many more working with the area as executive of an educational services organization.
